***CONTRACT BETWEEN COORDINATOR AND THIRD COUNTRY PARTNER
(PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT)***

The **Faculty of Biology, University of Belgrade** established in Studentski trg 3, Belgrade, POB 52, 11001, Serbia (“**FBUB**” or “**Coordinator**”), represented by Željko Tomanović, Dean, and/or Pavle Andjus, Head of Centre for laser microscopy, or their authorised representative

of the **one part**

and **Fundación centro de alta tecnología** established in Calle Costa Rica, Pavas, San José 1174-1200, Costa Rica (“**LANOTEC**” or *Partner*), represented by _____ Allan Campos _____ and person in charge Yendry Corrales Ureña or their duly authorised representatives,

of the **other part**

HAVE AGREED to the following terms and conditions established in this contract and its annexes (the “*contract*”).

Article 1

The **Faculty of Biology, University of Belgrade** in the capacity of *coordinator* is the contractor of the project called *AUTOMATED FUNCTIONAL SCREENING OF IgGs FOR DIAGNOSTICS OF NEURODEGENERATIVE DISEASES - AUTOIGG* (“*Project*”) within the framework of the specific research and innovation programme “*Excellent Science - Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions*”, financed by the **European Community**

The scope and implementation of the project, the consortium as well as the third country partner, and the financial costs and provisions of the project per each participant are set out in the *Grant Agreement* no 778405 and Annex I therein.

Article 2

The resources and tasks of **LANOTEC** available to the project as set out in the Annex I to the *Grant Agreement* are the following:

1. Organization of a 10-month study visit (in total) for an experienced researcher from the *Coordinator (FBUB)*.
2. Organization of a 3 month visit (in total) of an experienced researcher from the *Coordinator (FBUB)*.
3. Organization of a 1-month visit (in total) for an experienced researcher from the *Coordinator (FBUB)*.
4. Organization of a 1-month visit (in total) for an experienced researcher from AUTOIGG participant *ELVESYS, Paris, France*.
5. Person in charge at **LANOTEC** will participate at least twice at the Annual project meetings in the course of the 4-year project. It is expected that for other meetings he will be participating via internet media communications.

**Article 3**

The Coordinator agrees to pay the incoming person visiting LANOTEC in accordance with the provisions of the Annex II to the *Grant Agreement*, 2,000 € (two thousands euro) per month of visit, and a financial contribution for the resources and tasks (*operational costs*) of the host in summed amount up to 2,500 € (two thousand five hundred euro) per each month of the visit. Upon request (in accordance with Article 4), a part of the above operational cost may be used to cover whole or part of the economic price of travel as stated in Article 2.5.

Article 4

At regular periods (bi- or trimestral) during the secondments to LANOTEC the two parties to the contract will jointly agree on which of the planned tasks have been performed and the Coordinator will pay to the Partner (LANOTEC) a financial contribution in accordance with Article 3. The contribution can also be made in advance upon joint agreement of the two parties.

In cases of underperformance in terms of implemented person-months, the partners will inform the Supervisory Board. The Supervisory Board will alert the Secondment Committee to revise or reshuffle and expedite the secondments plan. The Supervisory Board is entitled to decide on changes in the allocation of the person-months and according total Funding amount paid to a Party in cases of underperformance (also see Grant Agreement Annex 1 Description of Action).

Article 5

The Court of Commerce in Belgrade shall have sole jurisdiction to hear any disputes between the Coordinator and the Third country Partner as regards the validity, the application or any interpretation of this *contract*.
